

<u>Alpha Court (807) 683-8200</u> (This agency does not provide counselling)

Access: Must be 16+, call-in/walk-in, first come, first serve. No appointments available.

Services Available: Information on mental health and addictions services, housing, employment and financial supports, assistance with appropriate referrals, and connect with the Alpha Court Day Centre.

Canadian Mental Health Association (807) 345-5564 (This agency does not provide counselling)

Access: Must be 16+, call-in/walk-in, first come, first serve. Appointments may be available.

District Access: Call to be connected with our talk-in clinic.

Services Available: Mental health support, Information on mental health and addiction services, housing, employment and financial supports, assistance with appropriate referrals, and CMHA programming.
